

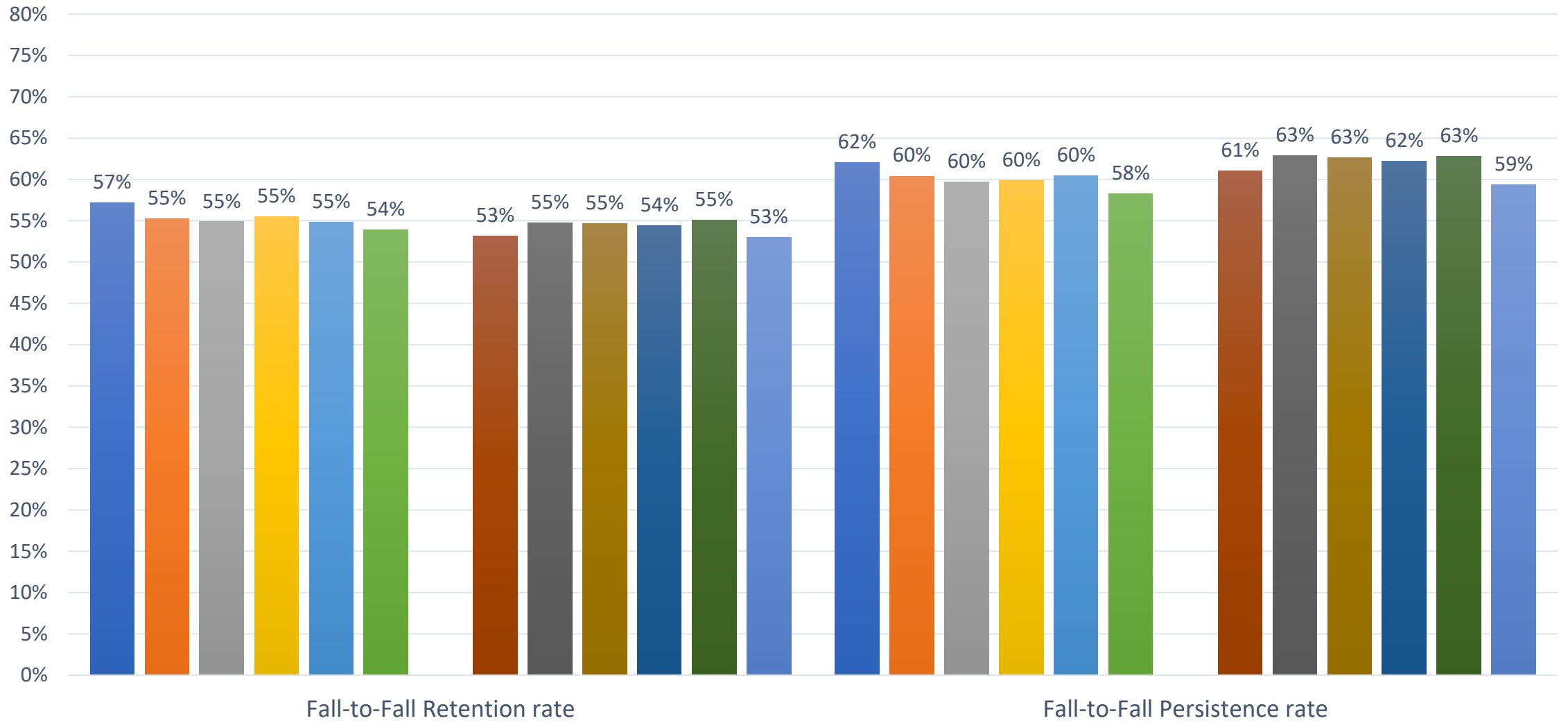

Fall 2014 to 2019 Entering Cohorts

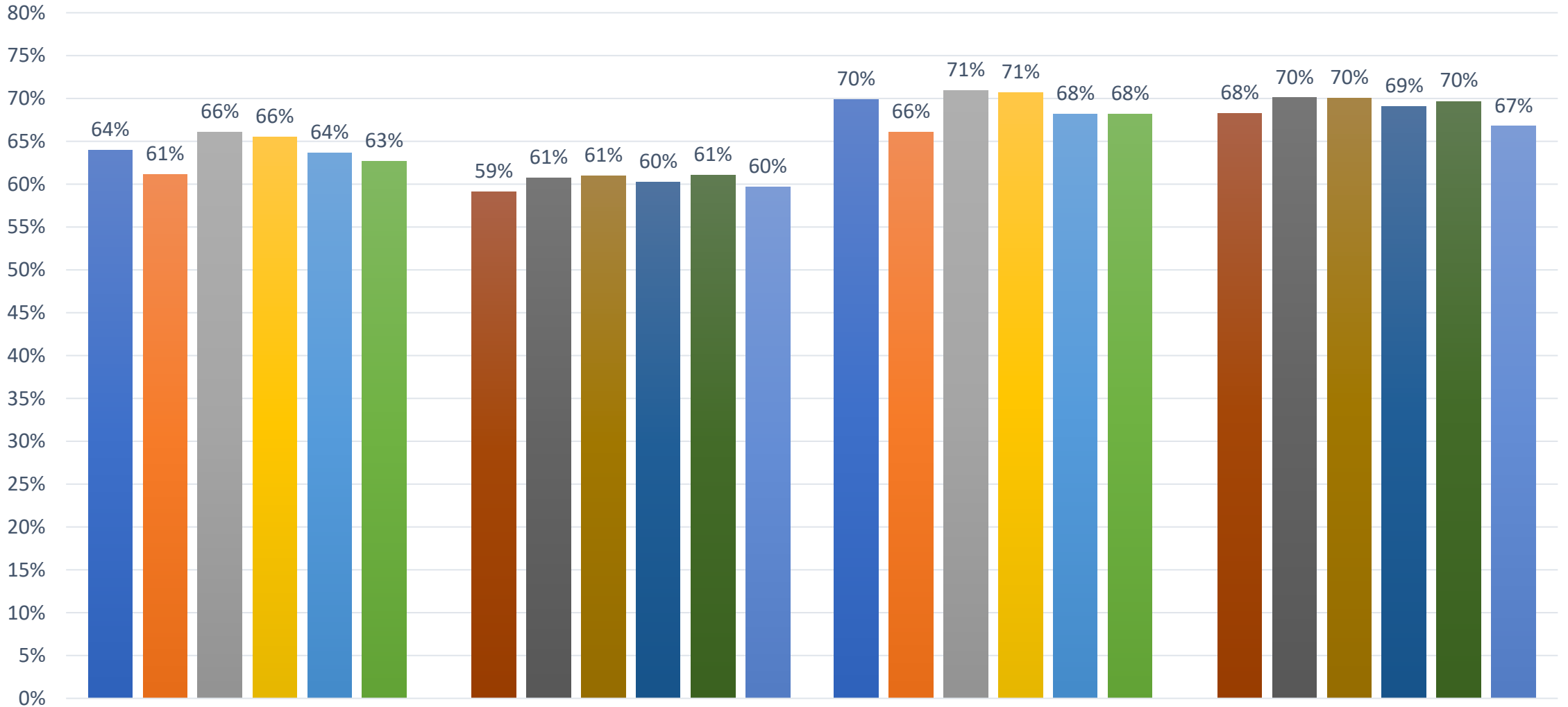
Notes: Entering cohorts include all first-time students with no college enrollment in the previous four years who have not previously completed a degree. Current dual enrolled students are not included, but previously dual enrolled students are. Retention is defined as Fall-to-Fall enrollment or completion at the same institution, where persistence is the same, but at any institution. Historical data have been revised to reflect methodological changes/enhancements.

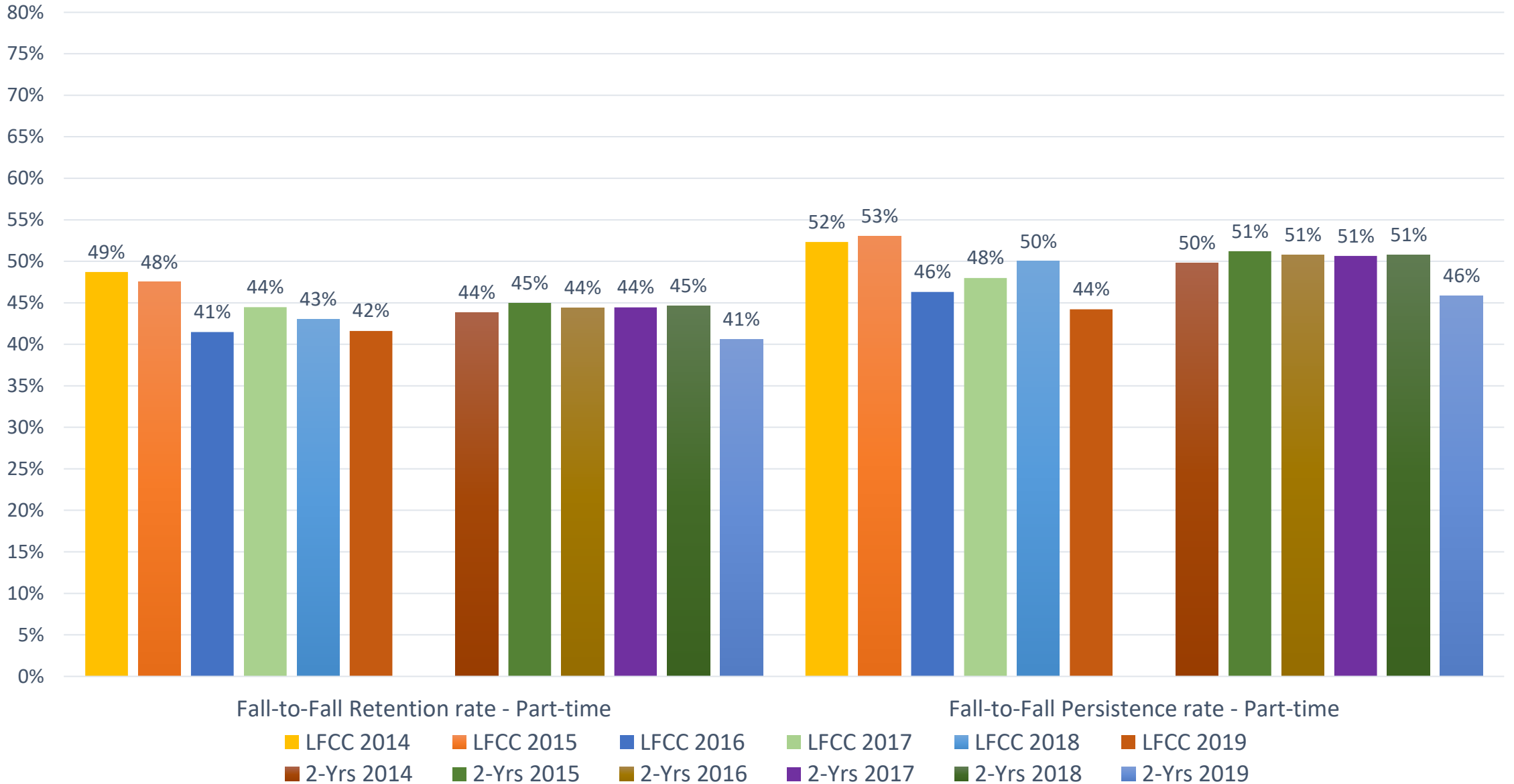


Fall-to-Fall Retention rate - Full-time

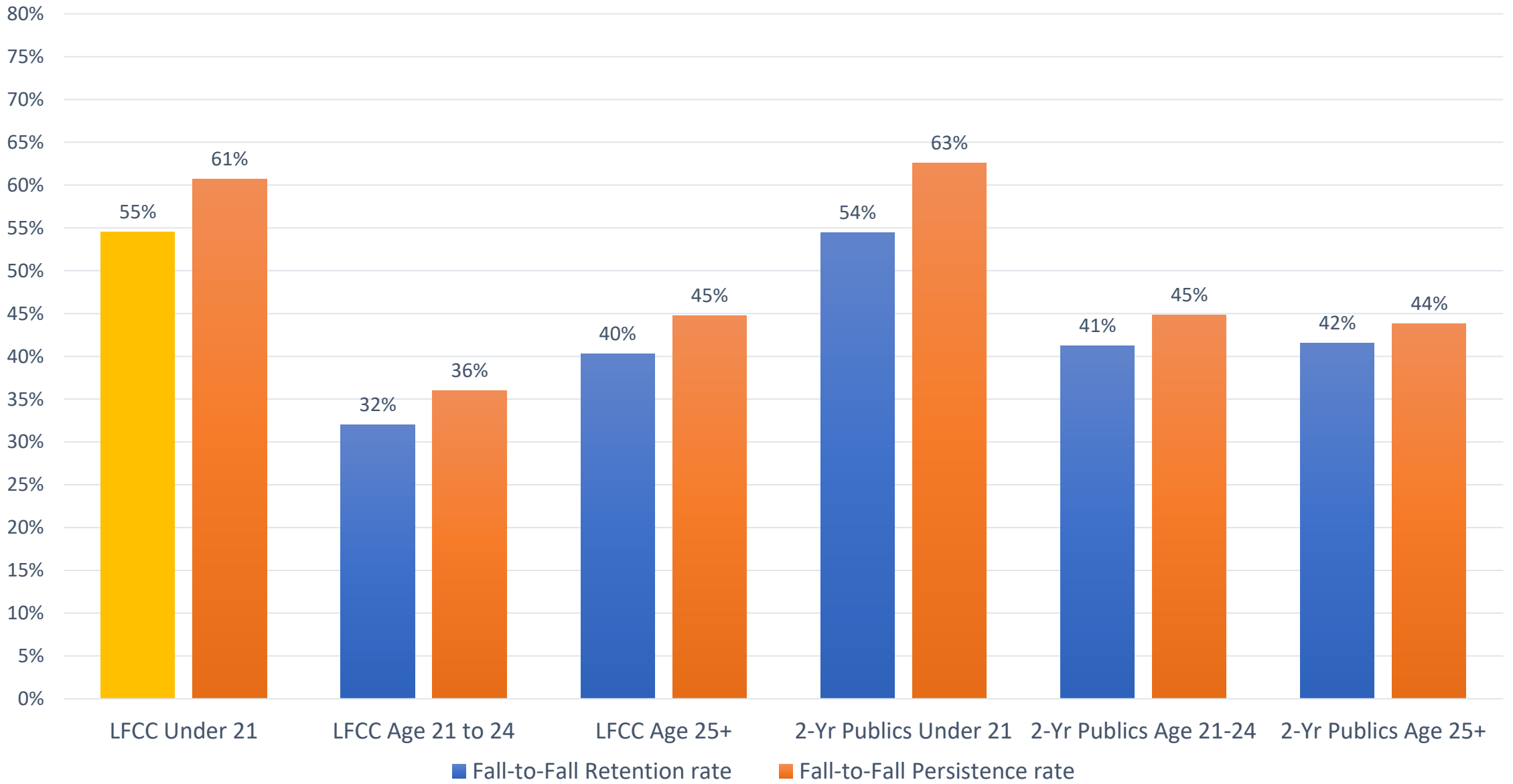

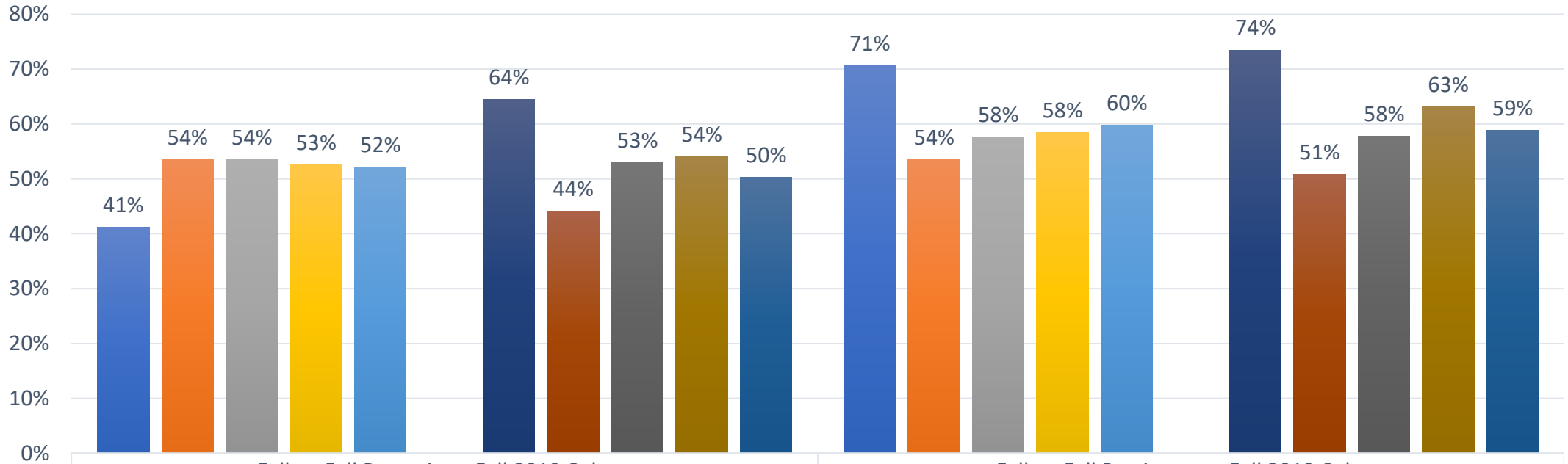
Trends in Retention and Persistence Rates by Cohort – Part-time
