

SOURCES: These reports are based on official, Virginia Community College System (VCCS) annual and fall semester, master data files produced for enrollments and awards for 2020-21 and for fall 2020 demographics. The data on courses are based on course information currently available in the PeopleSoft Student Information System for sections offered by LFCC's academic division for dual enrollment (ICDUAL).

HIGH SCHOOL – Schools are identified using the CEEB code in the annual data files for students enrolled in dual enrollment academic plans. While students may change schools during the year, only one CEEB code is documented per student in the VCCS annual enrollment and completions data files.

ENROLLMENT – Annual enrollment data are reported for all students with academic program plan codes and other variables used by the VCCS to document dual enrollment status.

AWARDS – Annual awards data are reported for all students with academic program plan codes and other variables used by the VCCS to document dual enrollment status. The data do not include awards earned by previously dual enrolled students after they graduated from high school and completed the period of dual enrollment. The table on Annual Number of DE Students Earning Awards is unduplicated, in that it counts each student only once, regardless of how many awards a student may earn. The tables on Annual Total Awards to DE Students and Annual Total Awards by Program include all awards by type/level and program plan and students are counted more than once if they earned more than one award during this time period.

COURSES – Courses are listed if sections of the course were taught with one or more students at public high schools within each jurisdiction. These are identified using the location code and facility description. Total students enrolled in each course are listed. The courses may include multiple sections at different high schools. A student may be counted in more than one course if so enrolled. Labs are not usually included, since most labs do not award credit. Information about Governor's School courses and the EMT and Trades Academies that serve DE students is also reported.

Counts of unique course offerings and other data are provided in the Course Information table. Sections taught by semester is an estimate based on the data available, since courses may last more than one semester and sections can teach more than one course during the school year. The number of dual enrollment instructors per jurisdiction is based on distinct names and identifiers in the course data file in PeopleSoft SIS. Some instructor data may not have been updated once the course was offered, so this is based on available data.

DEMOGRAPHICS – Race/Ethnicity data are collected on LFCC students using the VCCS Application form. These data were recently updated by the VCCS. Updated annual data are not yet available, so fall 2020 data are reported. The VDOE Fall Membership Table Generator was used for race/ethnicity data for all students in grades 9 to 12 for the 2020-21 school year. VDOE staff provided data on gender, which are not included in the Table Generator. LFCC DE and High School demographic data are compared for fall 2020 by race/ethnicity and gender.
