



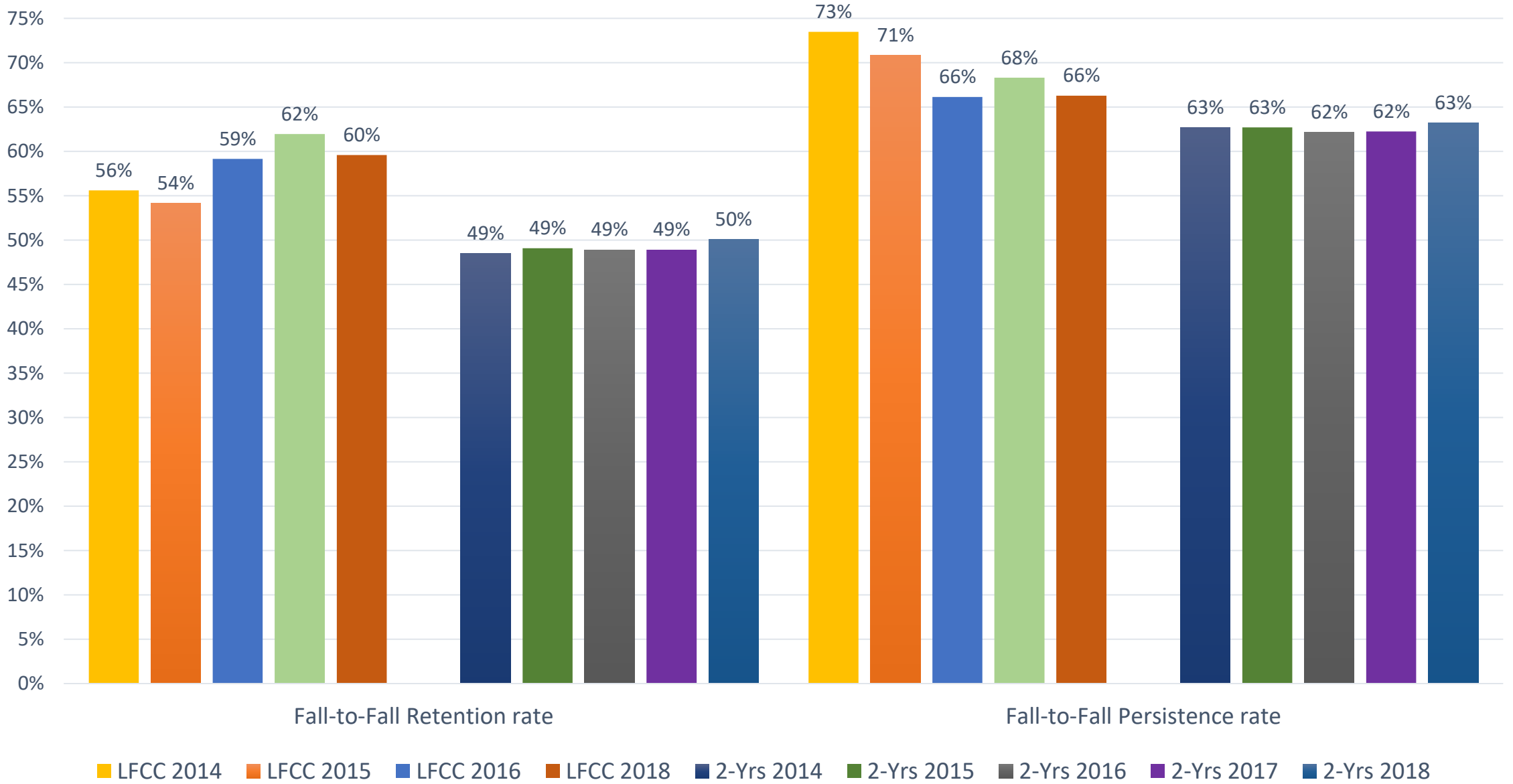

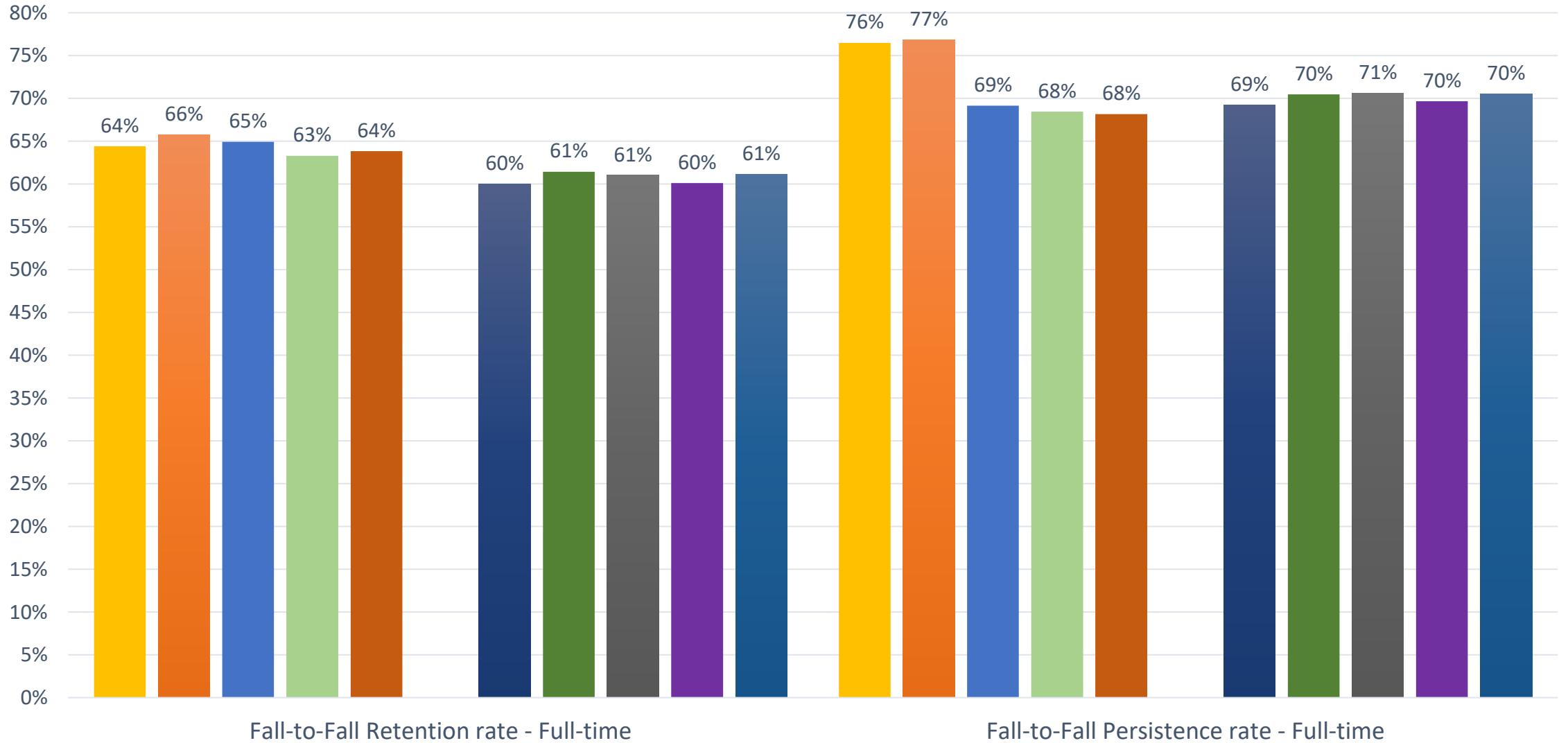
Fall 2014 to 2018 Entering Cohorts

Trends in Retention and Persistence Rates by Cohort - Overall

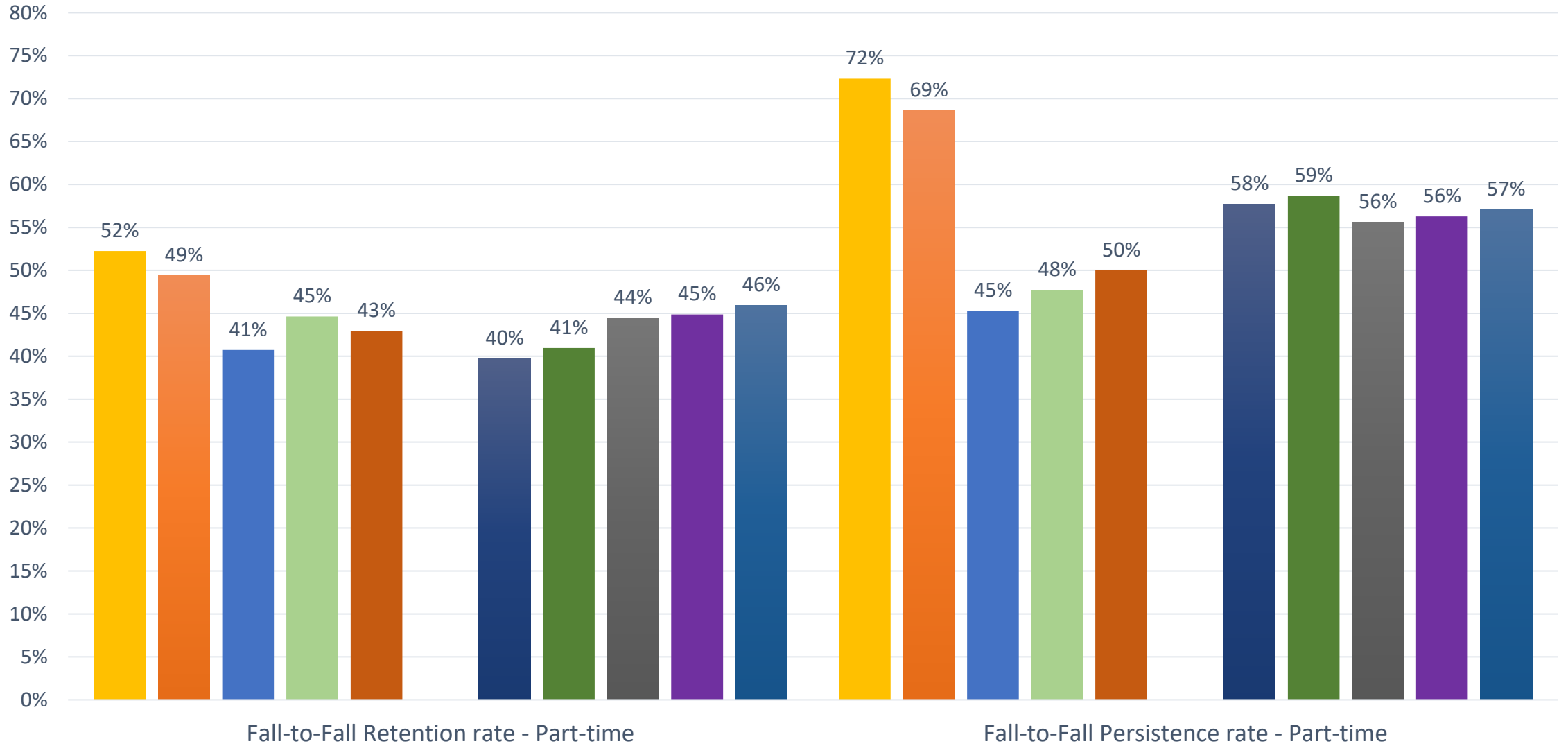


Trends in Retention and Persistence Rates by Cohort – Full-time



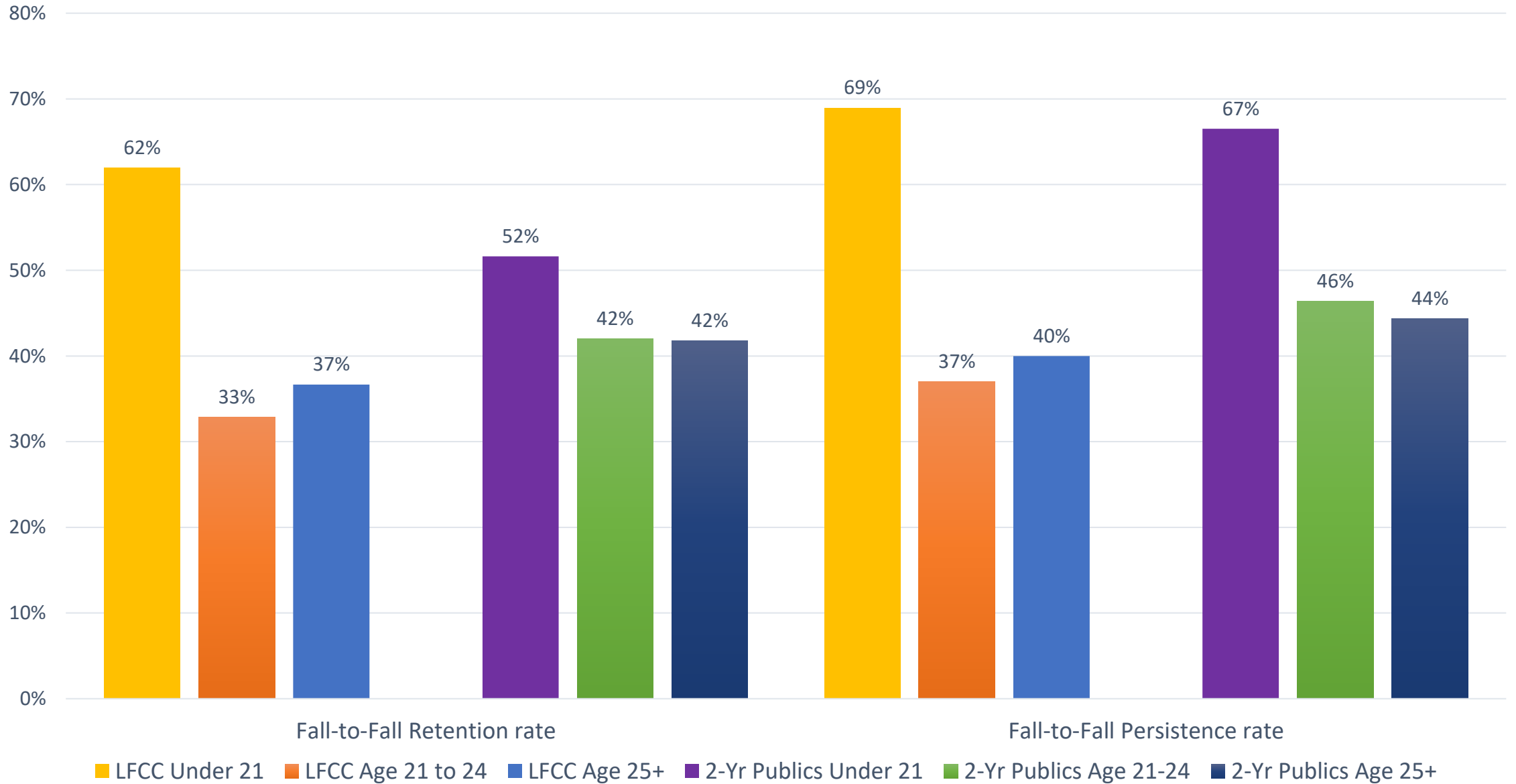

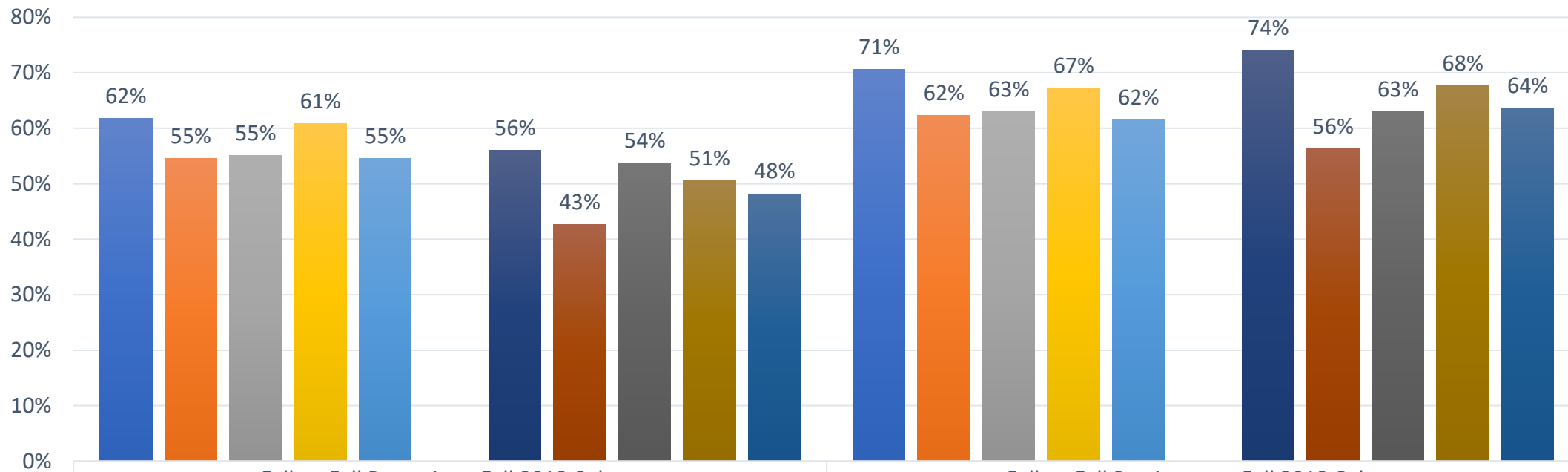
